1. What cookies are

Cookies are small text files stored on the user device when visiting a website. They may be used to maintain a session, remember settings, or ensure the proper operation of selected service features.

2. What categories of cookies Mysteral uses

As of publication, Mysteral does not use marketing or advertising cookies. If analytics, marketing, or other optional technologies are added in the future, the relevant information and consent mechanism will be updated before they are activated.

- strictly necessary cookies: required for the proper operation of the service, login, session maintenance, security, and remembering the cookie decision;
- interface preference cookies: used to remember a user choice, for example the selected language of the interface.

3. Cookies currently used by Mysteral

Depending on the login flow or the authentication framework configuration, additional technical helper cookies may also appear, for example for form protection or redirect handling after login. If such cookies are actively used in production, the table should be extended with their names and storage periods.

4. Legal basis for using cookies

Cookies necessary for the service to operate and cookies needed to provide a feature expressly requested by the user may be used without separate consent where they are genuinely necessary for the service or electronic communication.

If optional cookies are added in the future, for example analytics or marketing cookies, they will only be activated after obtaining the appropriate user consent.

5. How to manage cookies

Restricting or blocking necessary cookies may cause login, session maintenance, language memory, or other app functions to stop working properly.

- cookie settings available in the service;
- your web browser settings;
- deleting stored cookies from the device.

6. Analytics and marketing cookies

As of publication, Mysteral does not use marketing or advertising cookies.

Before publication, it should still be confirmed that the service does not use any optional analytics cookies at the hosting, external tools, or embedded infrastructure-provider level.
